




FITTING PROCEDURE



Remove factory front & diff stone guards from vehicle and set aside front 2 fasteners. 1.




2. Remove factory transmission guard from



3. Position M8 cage nuts into front panel as shown.



4. Position M10 cage nuts into nut plates as shown.




UVP FITTED IN CONJUNCTION WITH ARB BULL BAR

5. Loosely fasten ARB front panel to vehicle as shown using fasteners supplied in kit as well as 2x fasteners removed previously in step 1.


Note: When vehicle is equipped with bull bar, use 3xM8 fasteners (supplied with bull bar) to fix front edge of panel as shown.


6. Loosely fasten ARB diff panel to vehicle and Front Panel as shown using fasteners supplied in kit.

7. Loosely fasten ARB transmission/transfercase panel to vehicle and Diff Panel as shown using fasteners supplied in kit.

8. Tighten all fasteners beginning with sets fixing panels together and then move on to fastener sets fixing panels to chassis.
